Grant Provisions Continued

Eligible Applicants: Cities and CBOs

- 100 percent match
- Cities required to pass through 50 percent to CBOs
- Los Angeles may apply for \$2 million per fiscal year on a non-competitive basis per statute

Assembly Bill 1603

- Limited eligibility to cities that are disproportionately impacted by violence and the CBOs that serve them
- Expanded the type of organizations that were eligible to count towards a city's 50% pass-through
 - CBOs
 - Public agencies or departments that are primarily dedicated to community safety or violence prevention



Proposal Submission

Overview

- 83 Proposals Considered for Funding:
 - 15 cities
 - 53 CBOs
 - 15 Sm. Scope CBOs
- \$160 Million Requested
 - \$50 million from cities
 - \$104 million from CBOs
 - \$6 million from Sm. Scope CBOs

Recommendation

The CalVIP ESC recommends that the Board

- Allocate the FY 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24 appropriations;
- Fully fund 15 city proposals, 50 CBO, and 14 small scope CBO proposals;
- Fund the City of Los Angeles in the amount of \$4 million.
