


Data Reflect Shifts in California's County Jail Population

Note. In 2007 there were a total of 59 reporting jurisdictions: 57 sheriff's departments or department of corrections (there were no facilities in Alpine County), Santa Ana Police Department, and Santa Clara Probation Department. Of the 59 reporting jurisdictions, 19 were small, 21 were medium, and 19 were large. In 2019, there were a total of 56 reporting jurisdictions: all sheriff's departments or departments of correction (there were no facilities in Alpine and Sierra counties). Of the 56 reporting jurisdictions, 18 were small, 20 were medium, and 18 were large.
