## Data Caveats \& Limitations

The following caveats and limitations have been identified for the Jail Profile Survey data:

- Source data can be queried at https://app.bscc.ca.gov/joq//jps/QuerySelection.asp
- We make every effort to verify the submitted data to ensure its accuracy, but it is ultimately up to the jurisdictions (counties) to report reliable data.
- Due to rounding, numbers and percentages presented may not add up precisely to the totals provided.
- We do not collect details on policies that jurisdictions enforce that might influence these data.
- Certain data are imputed from this report because the data are unavailable or incomplete. These missing values are replaced by the mean (average) of the 12 most recent non-missing values for the respective data point.
