

Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act - Youthful Offender Block Grant 2019 Expenditure and Data Report Due Date: October 1, 2019

On or before October 1, 2019, each county is required to submit to the Board of State & Community Corrections (BSCC) a report on its Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) and Youthful Offender Block Grant (YOBG) programs during the preceding year. For JJCPA this requirement can be found at Government Code (GC) Section 30061(b)(4)(C) and for YOBG it can be found at Welfare & Institutions Code Section (WIC) 1961(c). These code sections both call for a consolidated report format that includes a description of the programs and other activities supported by JJCPA and/or YOBG funds, an accounting of all JJCPA and YOBG expenditures during the prior fiscal year, and countywide juvenile justice trend data.

Prior to submitting this report save the file using the following naming convention: "(County Name) 2019 JJCPA-YOBG Report." For example, Yuba County would name its file "Yuba 2019 JJCPA-YOBG Report".

Once the report is complete, attach the file to an email and send it to: **JJCPA-YOBG@bscc.ca.gov**. All reports will be posted to the BSCC website. We encourage you to review your report for accuracy before sending it to the BSCC. Please do **NOT** change the report form to a PDF document.

Provide a summary description or analysis, based on available information, of how the programs, placements, services, strategies or system enhancements funded by JJCPA-YOBG have, or may have, contributed to, or influenced, the juvenile justice data trends identified in this report.

Data collection has continued to show fewer youth are being placed on formal probation and fewer violations are being filed in juvenile court. With regard to formal court dispositions of wardship, we have found an approximate 7.7% reduction in comparison to 2017 data and with regard to petitions filed an approximate 0.5% reduction. YOBG and JJCPA funding is used to complete risk and needs assessments, increase counseling services, enhance supervision services, provide Evidence- Based Programming, offer vocational training, provide enhanced educational opportunities, increase community service and engagement activities, administer gender specific programming and recreational activities, and provide for increased staff training and development.

Collaboration and regular meetings across various disciplines working with youth in both public and private sector are ongoing. Committees meet to address issues such as adverse childhood experiences, commercial sexual exploitation of children, placements, and gang intervention. Weekly meetings of the Inter-agency Placement Council (IPC), ensures systems partners' programs and policies reflect a coordinated, integrated, and effective delivery of services for children, youth, and families. The IPC continues to provide guidance, advice, and input to a broad range of programs for children and families, as requested by public and private agencies. Additionally, Probation continues to engage in a collaborative Systems Improvement Plan (SIP) incorporating county-wide strategies to work with Probation and Child Welfare youth across both systems.

Probation has developed existing continuum of services that strongly emphasizes collaboration across agency boundaries toward reducing crime and delinquency for delinquent and pre-delinquent youth. The County has a history of developing such inter-agency projects through dedication of pre-existing resources and maximizing external funding through a range of projects.

Probation continues to focus on family engagement and working with youth early on whom have become involved with the juvenile justice system. We initiate family finding during the intake process and we involve our youth by engaging with and encouraging them to supply as much information about family members, distant and near, as well as other supportive adults such as, teachers, coaches, neighbors etc., with whom they feel a connection. Our agency subscribes to a web-based system for our family finding, called LexisNexis. Actively involving our youth in this crucial decision-making process can help to prepare them for their transition back into the community and it has been proven that youth who are involved in the planning process take more responsibility for the success of the arrangement.

While in custody, youth are required to participate in pro-social programming designed to enhance practical life skills and reduce high risk behavior by addressing trauma. In order to address the treatment needs of youth while they are in our care, the Merced County Probation Department created a new position, the Probation Program Specialist (PPS). The PPS is responsible for managing and overseeing the day to day operations of the cognitive behavioral and/or evidence-based programs facilitated at the facility. This of course includes working with the facility staff to help enhance programing as a means to reduce risky behavior. Utilizing a trauma informed approach and healing centered engagement, the hope is to help youth understand the impact of their behavior (Legacy) leaves behind. The PPS oversees facilitators and performs quality inspections to ensure youth are learning new skills. The PPS also acts as a facilitator of several groups that help teach prosocial behaviors. In addition, the PPS conducts independent research and through data collection, recommends programs that have an everlasting impact for the youth. The PPS is also responsible for the planning and execution of special events: field days, curriculum ceremonies, holiday events, holiday activities, school graduations, etc. Lastly, the PPS provides staff training on Trauma Informed-Care and Cognitive Behavioral Techniques.

Merced County Probation operates a 60-bed camp program, Bear Creek Academy (BCA). 30 beds are dedicated to the Long Term (LT) and Youth Treatment Programs (YTP). The BCA programs are point-based with up to five phases. The program period is one to two years, depending on which program is utilized. Program elements include vocational education, alcohol and drug education, mental health counseling, and cognitive and life skills development. Participants will eventually earn home visits that will include GPS services. The final phase of the program will include aftercare to effectively transition youth into the community once released from the facility. A re-entry plan will be developed for each participant. Case management will be provided by an officer, to ensure adherence to the re-entry plan. The goals and expected benefits of the BCA is to reduce recidivism by offering local long term treatment and custody programs to high risk youth, and successfully transitioning youth into the community once released from the facility. YOBG funds offset the cost of staff and operating expenses associated with the 30-beds identified solely for the BCA LT and TYP programs. This is a one to two year camp program located inside the Juvenile Justice Correctional Complex.
