Description:

Youth Alliance (YA), a community based organization, provides case management; individual, parent and groups interactive workshops; referral services; and transition plans. Probation officers and a Youth Alliance case manager use a family meeting model to work collaboratively with local agencies, schools, families, and the youth to improve services and provide direction and support to these families. Youth referred to this organization participate in their El Joven Noble Program. El Joven Noble is a comprehensive indigenous based, youth leadership development program that supports and guides young men through their manhood "rites of passage" process while focusing on the prevention of substance abuse, teen pregnancy, relationship violence, gang violence and school failure. Parents participate in the Cara Y Corazon program, a culturally based family strengthening program.
