SUBJECT: **AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING FOR THE ADULT REENTRY GRANT - COHORT III**

The Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) is announcing the release of the Adult Reentry Grant Program Request for Proposals (RFP). This RFP makes \$63,650,000 available for a grant period that covers October 1, 2022 through April 30, 2026.

The Adult Reentry Grant program was established in the Budget Act of 2018 (Senate Bill 840, Chapter 29, Statutes of 2018) to provide funding for community-based organizations to deliver reentry services for people formerly incarcerated in state prison.

Eligible applicants are Community-Based Organizations located in the State of California that have been determined by the IRS to have 501(c)(3) status.

Proposals must be received by the BSCC by **5:00 p.m. on April 8, 2022**. A copy of the RFP is attached and is available on the BSCC [website](#).

A virtual Bidder's Conference will be held via Zoom on March 3, 2022 at 1:30 P.M. A link to the Bidder's Conference is provided within the RFP and will be posted on the BSCC website.
