# ORTP FUNDING

- ❖ Established in The State Budget Act of 2022 (Senate Bill 154, Chapter 43, Statutes of 2022).
- ❖ Funding available to city police departments, sheriff departments, and probation departments.
- ❖ Support local law enforcement agencies in preventing and responding to organized retail theft, motor vehicle theft (or accessory theft) or cargo theft.
- ❖ Total Funding Available: \$242,250,000
  - ❖ October 1, 2023 - JUNE 1, 2027

# RESPONSE TO RFP

## ❖ 114 Proposals Received

- \$341 million

## ❖ 38 Proposals Funded (\$242,250,000)

- 11 Large Proposals
- 23 Medium Proposals
- 1 Partial Proposal

# ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

- ❖ **Grant funds must be used to, but are not limited to, purchase of technology or other equipment to help deter strategies for preventing or responding to crime.**
